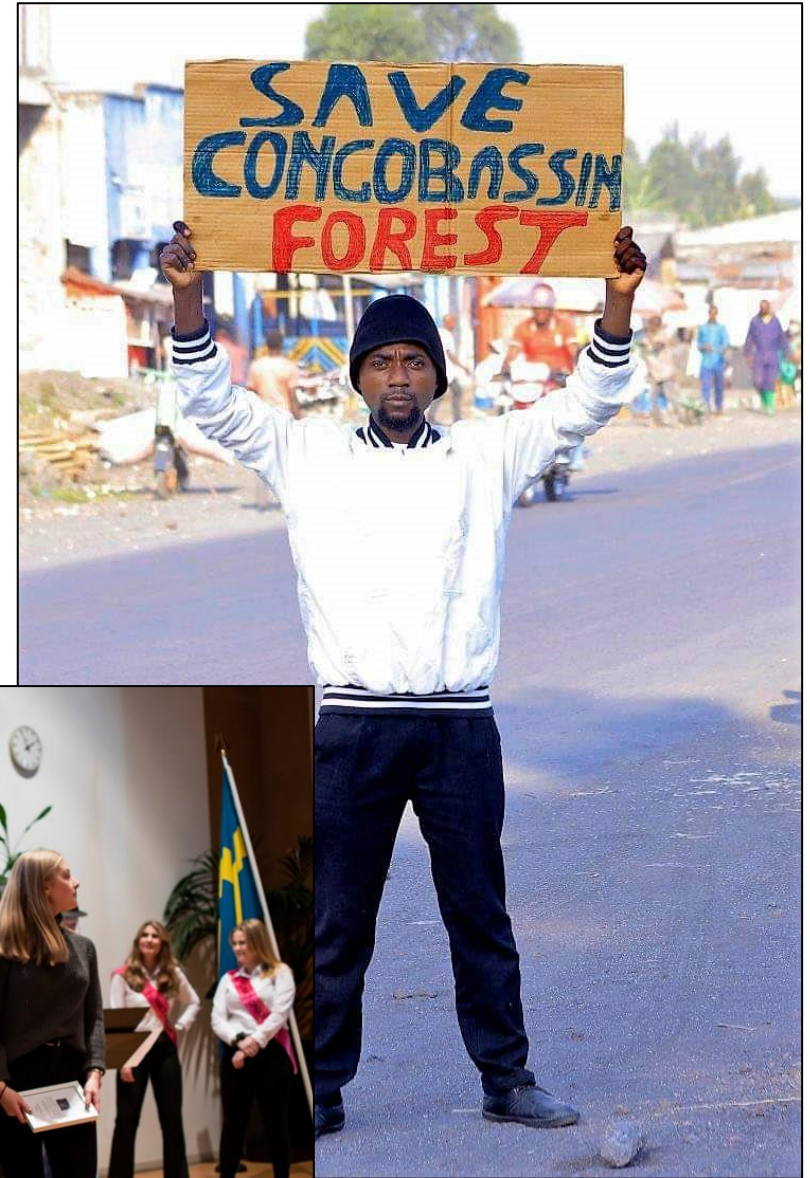

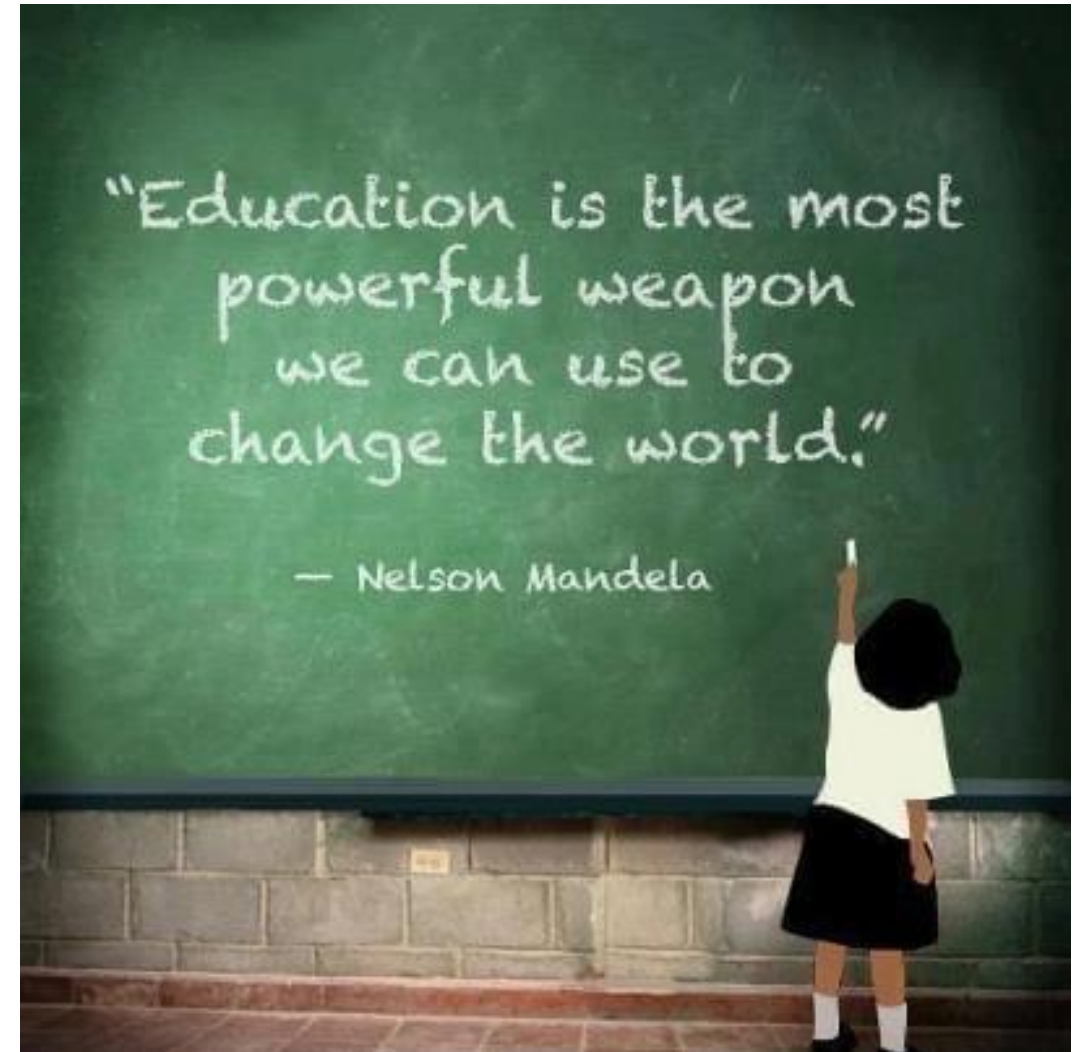


Education

Climate change



Summary of the UN IPCC report *Mitigation of Climate Change*

- Greenhouse gas emissions from 2010 to 2019 were the highest ever for any decade in human history.
- Emissions continue to increase mainly because the world's energy system is based on fossil sources and emissions from destroyed ecosystems.
- The costs of renewable energy have fallen sharply. Climate solutions such as solar and wind power, electric vehicles and battery storage have developed rapidly - but more needs to be done to phase out coal, oil and gas.
- The report confirms that the protection and restoration of natural ecosystems offers great opportunities by absorbing and locking carbon dioxide from the atmosphere.

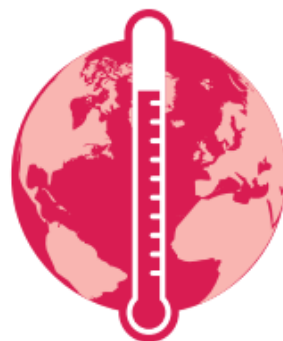


Loss of biodiversity



“Biodiversity is all the different kinds of life you’ll find in one area—the variety of animals, plants, fungi, and even microorganisms like bacteria that make up our natural world. Each of these species and organisms work together in ecosystems, like an intricate web, to maintain balance and support life. **Biodiversity supports everything in nature that we need to survive: food, clean water, medicine, and shelter.**”

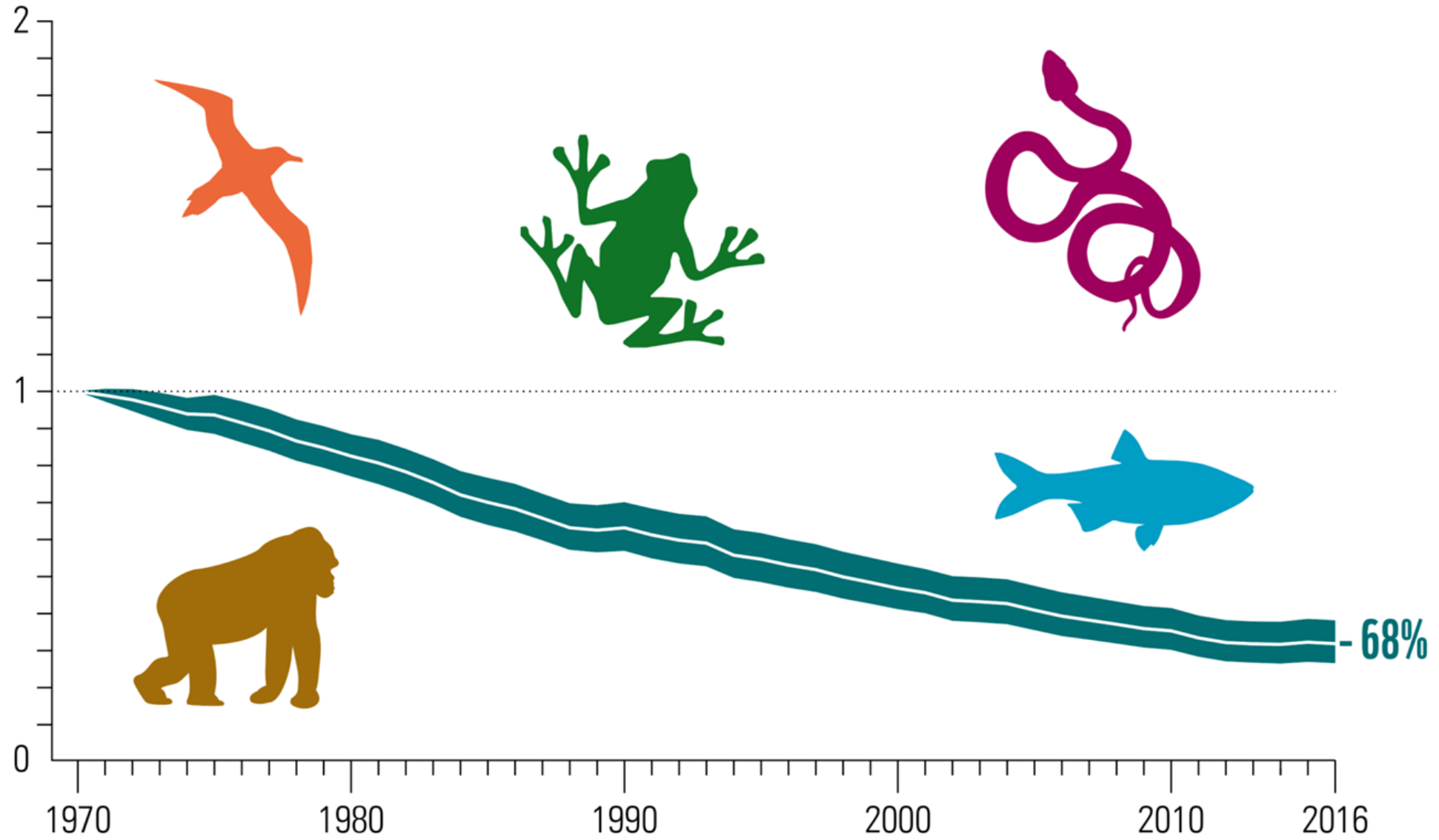

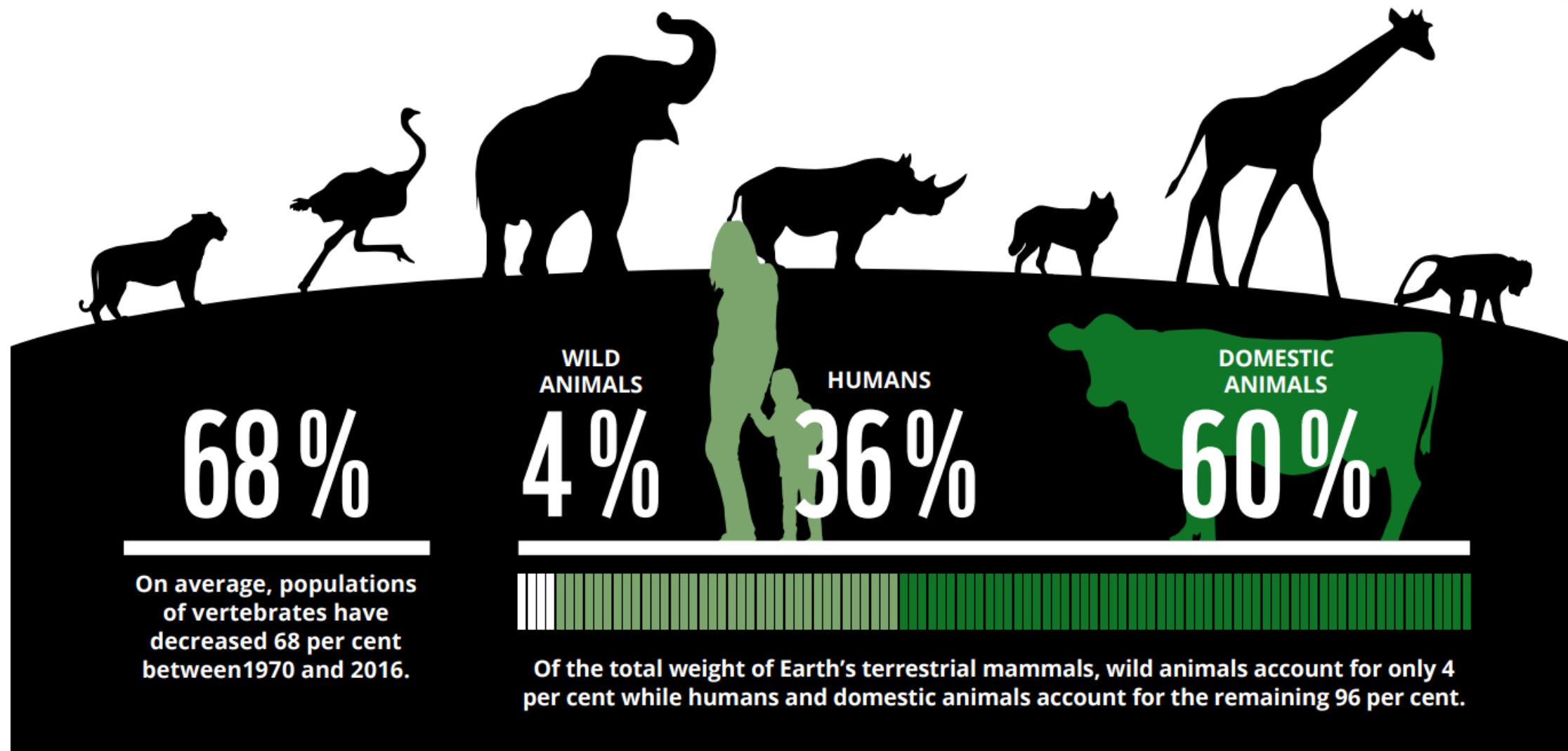

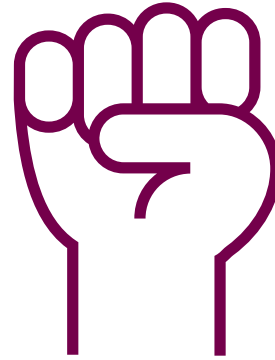
